Lisa Pellin Dancers

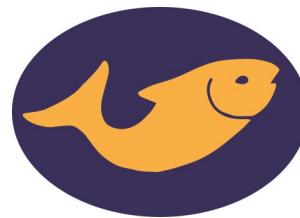
Lisa Pellin Dancers are currently taking enrolments for 2020.
